DEFINITION OF POSITION

Under general direction of the IT Manager, assists in performing a variety of technical duties in the operation of computer systems/software packages, data communications, operating systems and other technological applications.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Maintains, troubleshoots and upgrades the City's computer network as needed. Provides technical support for data communications, operating systems, and other related technologies.
- Plans, consults, researches, programs, installs, maintains, and troubleshoots computer network systems. Conducts network system and software upgrades, maintains network backup system. Analyzes system failures/problems; makes hardware and software recommendations to the IT Manager for approval.
- Protects City's business-sensitive information through prevention, detection, and removal of virus/spyware software. Diagnoses and resolves complex hardware and/or software problems which impact the network. Tests and implements new equipment, i.e. computers, scanners, printers, and related equipment and software. Manages the City's file, internet, and intranet servers, including the application of related hardware and system software upgrades.
- Provides staff support and technical assistance for departmental specialized computer needs, i.e., Public Works SCADA & CAD; Police Department specialized programs; Finance Department HTE; Management Services Department computerized records management system, etc.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES REQUIRED

- Knowledge of a variety of computer systems, computer programs and software, networks, technologies, principles and practices of providing technical information systems support; and of the techniques and methodology of installing, maintaining and troubleshooting hardware, software and peripheral information systems equipment..
- Ability to provide technical support to the City's information systems; ability to install, troubleshoot and maintain hardware, software and related peripheral equipment; ability to analyze system failures/problems and take action to correct those failures/problems; and ability to assist system users.
- Bachelor's degree in computer science, management information systems, or a closely related field; supplemented by three years of progressively responsible information systems experience to include providing technical support in a Windows environment; or an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience.
- Valid California driver's license and an acceptable driving record.
- Ability to rotate "on-call" shifts.
